## CHRIST, THE GLORIOUS MASTER

**LESSON TEXT:** Matthew 16:21-28; 17:1-13

**LESSON SETTING:** In the region of Caesarea Philippi-25 miles north of the Sea of Galilee. Several days later Jesus went up on a high mountain accompanied by three disciples, Peter, James and John.

**TIME:** About 32 A.D.

**QUARTERLY THEME:** Christ - King and Savior

**TOPIC:** CHRIST, MASTER OF DEMONS

**INTRODUCTION:**

Although Satan is terrifyingly strong, Christ is still Master over Satan's demons. We cannot fully realize how terrible Satan's power is, but he must leave where the Spirit of Christ is. His demons may torment us with doubts and fears, with pain and illness, but if we are God's children, we know He is Master over all. He has all power over all demons.

Sometimes we feel as if all is darkness and the demons hold full sway. Then the Holy Spirit brings to our remembrance that God is still in His heaven and watches over all. What a wonderful assurance we have of God's power! Nothing can befall us but with what His power can cope. Our faith is often tested by His delay in proving His power and like the boy's father we cry out with tears, "Lord, I believe, help thou mine unbelief."

A sinner is bound by the demons who have control of his heart, but Christ can set him free. However, the sinner must choose to be set free, to surrender, to give up self, to repent and to accept Christ as his Master. It is up to each individual to make the choice.

**CENTRAL TRUTH:** God bestows His favor and blessing on those who are pleasing to Him.

**GOLDEN TEXT:** *ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE TO HIM THAT BELIEVETH.*

Mark 9:23

God is the source of all power. It is "in Him we live, and move, and have our being." All of this power has been given to Christ, the Son of God. Jesus said: "*All power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth.*" (Matthew 28:18) Unless God permits, man can do nothing. How truly Jesus said to His disciples, "Without me ye can do nothing." It is in the weakness of man that God's power is manifested.

If we realize our own weakness, we can by faith have access to the power of God. After many experiences in the service of the Gospel of Christ, Paul could write, "*I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.*" (Philippians 4:13)

May we ever be encouraged in faith to enlist the power of God in our battles with the evil one. Our faith in God's grace insures a winning race.
